Note 1: data para 11 and 12 may be delivered later, but well before the visitors and vehicles report at the gate. The guiding principle here is that the relevant agencies are not accessible outside normal working hours.

Note 2: if the activities mentioned in para 8 are more than the standard permitted activities, the minimum application period of three working days will take effect. This also applies to special activities requested later on (after measuring).
